

Quick Guide Tertiary Performance - ITR App

This app allows you to explore all the data used to calculate the industry training sector educational performance indicators (EPIs):

- cohort-based programme completion rate,
- credit achievement rate, and
- first year retention rate for New Zealand Apprentices.







Examples of what you can discover

- See trends in all EPI results over time.
- View EPIs broken down by learner demographics and programme NZSCED.
- Find participation rates by ethnicity and learners who are under 25 years old.
- View parity results.

Things to note

- Data in this app is from 2011 onwards up to latest year that EPIs have been published.
- Only industry training performance data is included in this app.
- The summary sheets provide a high level overview of performance. The detailed sheets allow you to carry out in-depth analysis.
- The latest submitted data is used to calculate the EPIs.
- If a learner reports two or more ethnicities, they will be counted once in each ethnicity. This means the total count by individual ethnicity may be greater than the total number of learners shown.
- All measures are suppressed if the values are below 5 for privacy reasons.
- The app provides a link to methodology and rules for calculating the EPIs.

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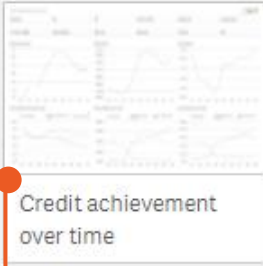

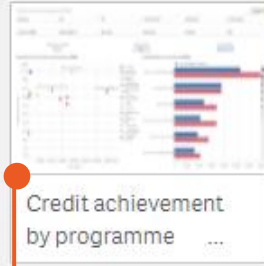
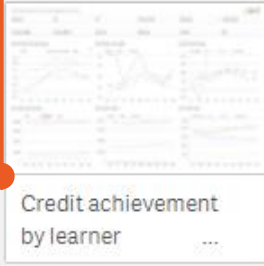

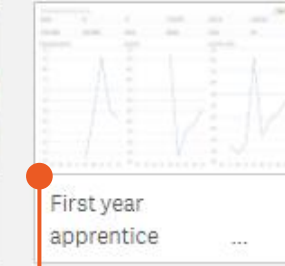
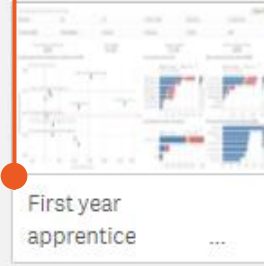
Credit achievement rate, achieved and expected credits by TEO, programme NZSCED and ethnicity group.



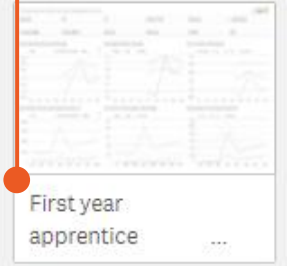
Credit achievement rate and expected credits by learner demographics (ethnicity group, gender and age) over time.

First year apprentice retention rate and number of learners by learner demographics over time.

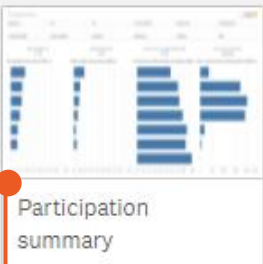
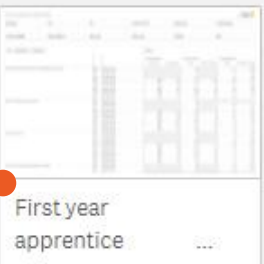


Credit achievement rate, achieved and expected credits by cohort group over time.

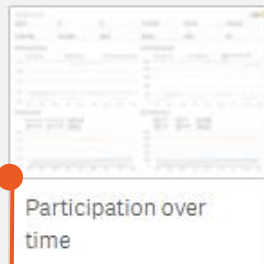
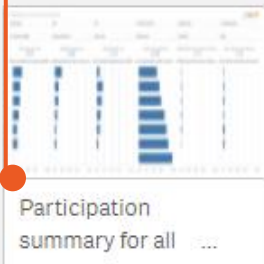
Credit achievement rate and achieved and expected credits by programme NZSCED to identify performance patterns.

First year apprentice retention rate and number of learners over time.

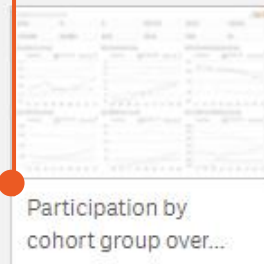
Detail of first year apprentice retention rates.

Participation rate and number of learners by age over time.

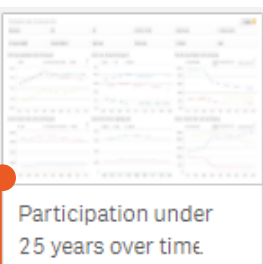


Participation rate for Māori, Pasifika and non-Māori and non-Pasifika and number of learners with known ethnicity by programme NZQF level.
